Terms and Conditions:

- 1 All equipment is used under the LESSEE'S risk and assumes responsibility for same until it is returned to the LESSOR.
- 2 LESSEE makes every effort to insure proper working conditions of the equipment but does not guarantee equipment against failure of any kind.
- 3 Rental paid by LESSEE is to cover ordinary wear only. LESSOR has the right to examine and test such equipment upon its return to determine any unusual wear or damages whether from use, transport or handling.
- 4 If repairs or replacement are required, the LESSEE agrees to pay all material, labor, and shipment charges in addition to the rental rates.
- 5 LESSEE shall pay LESSOR total sum necessary to replace any equipment that is lost, stolen or damaged beyond repair.
- 6 If such repairs or replacements in the field are required, the LESSEE will notify the LESSOR and the LESSOR will issue the proper authorization to make such repairs.
- 7 LESSEE is responsible for becoming familiar with operation procedures and proper use of the equipment and will not, under any circumstances, after the equipment or use it for any purpose other than for which it was manufactured or designed.
- 8 Access to the event site for install and/or removal is the responsibility of the LESSEE.
- 9 Location site shall be clear of any obstructions by LESSEE, when and where equipment will be constructed by LESSOR. Failure to have location site cleared of any materials inhibiting construction may result in additional charges.
- 10 Any changes to equipment, labor dates, and/or times may result in additional charges.
- 11 If confirmation of rental is not received, LESSOR cannot guarantee that the equipment and labor will be available for LESSEE'S job.
- 12 Payment for services are due upon agreed date within contract by LESSEE.
- 13 It is further agreed that any failure of payment upon the dates and terms agreed upon gives LESSOR the right to remove said equipment from the location site and charge LESSEE for all labor, handling and all transportation charges in addition to the full amount of the rental.
- 14 LESSEE also agrees to pay all attorneys fees and all reasonable court costs and all damages to LESSOR upon failure of payment of collection of charges, and failure to perform under any of the provisions listed.
