

DJUSD BOARD CANDIDATE SELECTION/VOTING PROCESS

JUNE/JULY 2020

June 25, 2020

The Board will hear/receive a three-minute presentation from each candidate. Following the presentations, through a voting process, the Board will select a candidate by the following voting process:

1. Each Board member will have a ballot to complete at the conclusion of the presentation by the candidates.
2. Each Board member will submit five (5) candidates or unused vote in the first round of voting. The results will be publicly announced. Those candidates receiving less than two (2) votes will be eliminated. If there are more than five (5) candidates remaining after first vote, there may be an additional round submitting three (3) candidates.
3. If there is a second round of voting, each Board member will submit three (3) of the remaining candidates or unused vote. The results will again be announced. Those candidates receiving less than two (2) votes will be eliminated.

July 2, 2020

The Board will conduct an interview with the remaining candidates from the June 25 Board meeting. Following the interviews, through a voting process, the Board will select a candidate by the following voting process:

1. Each Board member will have a ballot to complete at the conclusion of the interviews.
2. If there are seven (7) or more candidates, each Board member will submit three (3) of the remaining candidates or unused vote. If there are six (6) or fewer candidates, each Board member will submit two (2) of the remaining candidates or unused vote. The results will be announced. Those candidates receiving less than two (2) votes will be eliminated. The results will again be announced. Those candidates receiving less than two (2) votes will be eliminated. If there is only one candidate selected with three (3) or more votes, that person will be the Board's appointee.
3. If there are four (4) or more candidates from the first round, there will be a second round of voting, each Board member will submit two (2) of the remaining candidates or unused vote. The results will again be announced. Those candidates receiving less than two (2) votes will be eliminated. If there is only one candidate selected with three (3) or more votes, that person will be the Board's appointee. The voting will continue until there are three (3) or fewer candidates remaining.
4. In the subsequent round of voting, each Board member will submit one of the remaining candidates or unused vote. If one person receives three (3) or more votes, that person will be the Board's appointee.
5. Those candidates receiving no votes will be eliminated. The voting will continue until a candidate receives three (3) or more votes or until it is clear that an impasse has been reached.

In the case of an impasse, the Board will consider other courses of actions.
