AIR FILTER MONITORING

HDT is piloting air filter sampling at two DJUSD schools to detect the presence of COVID-19 in classrooms, complementing weekly opt-in testing

PROGRAM GOALS

• Provide **passive monitoring** of classrooms when daily testing of students is not feasible

PROCESS OVERVIEW

- Once per week, DJUSD testing staff swab **portable** HEPA filters in each classroom
- Samples are processed at the UCD Genome Center with results within 24-48 hours
- DJUSD reports results on website, follows **defined safety protocol,** and replaces the air filter

POSITIVE RESULT OVERVIEW

Tells us...

 Individual(s) entered the classroom that shed virus within the last seven days (or since the last filter sample or replacement)

Does not tell us...

- The source of the virus (student or staff)
- If he/she is currently infectious/shedding virus

Results in...

- The entire school population is notified
- Individuals within the classroom are encouraged to get tested and quarantine if necessary
- DJUSD testing staff collect swabs twice per week in the following weeks

RAPID ON-SITE TESTING

HDT is piloting rapid, point-of-care antigen tests (Abbott BinaxNOW) at three DJUSD schools to test both symptomatic and exposed students and staff members

PROGRAM GOALS

 Identify and isolate infectious cases by providing rapid results to symptomatic or exposed students and staff members

PROCESS OVERVIEW

- **Symptomatic or exposed** individuals are identified by school nurses, via contact tracing, or self-identification
- A trained DJUSD nurse conducts a BinaxNOW test (if testing waiver is completed by parent) using a gentle swab in the front of an individual's nose
- Individual is isolated until a result is available (usually within 15 minutes)

POSITIVE RESULT OVERVIEW

Tells us...

• Individuals that are infectious (84% sensitivity)

Does not tell us...

 Individuals that have COVID-19 at noninfectious levels or previously had COVID-19

Results in...

- Positive individual is quarantined for 10 days
- HDT and DJUSD Contact Tracing identify potential contacts
- Classmates and close contacts are quarantined for 10 days and recommended to get tested



SYMPTOMATIC STUDENT ACTION PROTOCOL


The following steps should be taken in response to a student presenting COVID-19 symptoms
