




Defining Ethnic Studies

- Inform the Ethnic Studies program recommendation for Board adoption in fall 2021


Selection and Composition

- Membership of about fifteen (15) participants, including students, staff, and community
- Applications available between Thursday, May 13 and Wednesday, May 26
- Selection of Advisory members will be conducted by District staff
- Applicants will be considered based on how their knowledge, experience, or education would contribute to the work of the committee
- The duration of the work for this Advisory Committee will last until the recommendation to the Board in the fall of 2021
