## **Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant AB/SB 86**

Implement a learning recovery program, that at a minimum, provides supplemental instruction, support for social and emotional well-being, and, to the maximum extent permissible under the guidelines of the United States Department of Agriculture, meals and snacks to specified student groups who have faced adverse learning and social-emotional circumstances.

7. Training for school staff

# DJUSD Instructional Coherence Map

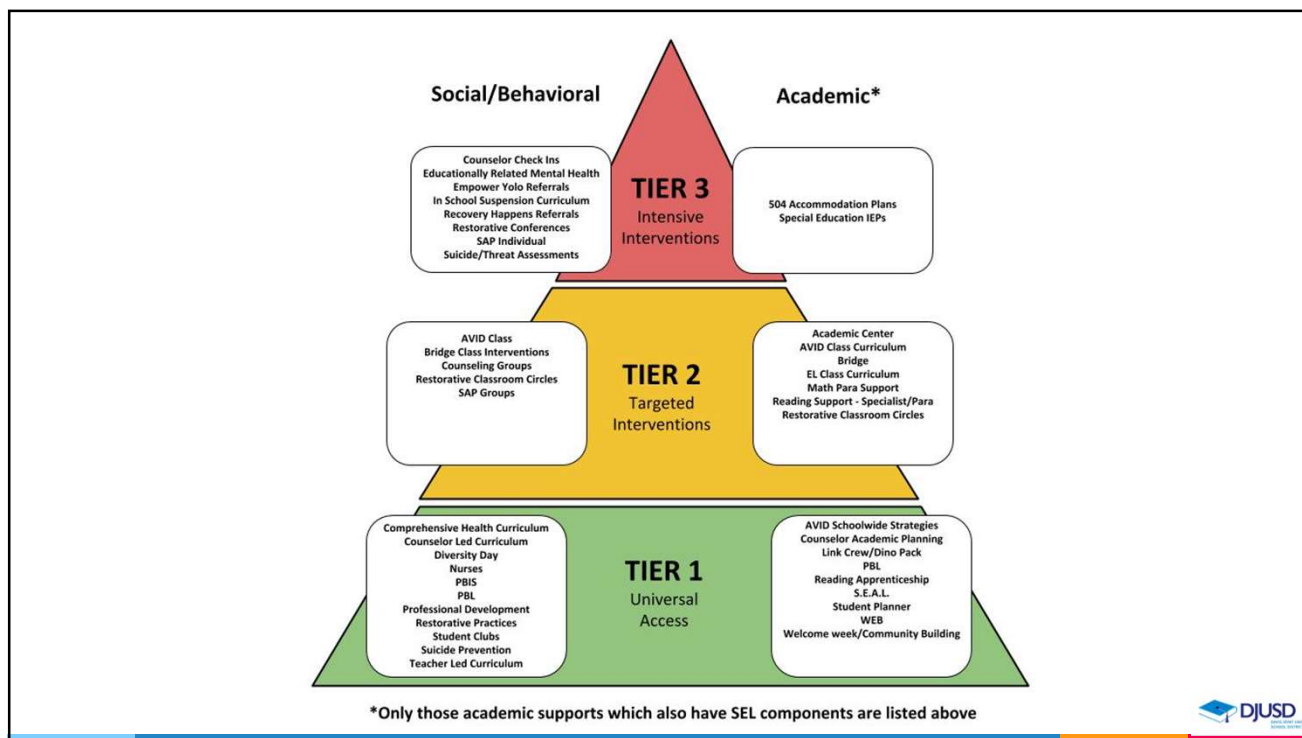
