

SNS, STUDENT BENEFITS FROM UWCCR VENDING AGREEMENT



- Overall Higher Quality Food and Service
 - Purchase Fruits and Vegetables Direct from Certified Organic Farms in Yolo County
 - Purchase Mary's Chicken, which promotes sustainable farming practices
 - Purchase Beef Direct from Yolo County
- Increase serving stations in Secondary Schools for higher quality service and more efficient lunch lines

SNS, DISTRICT BENEFITS FROM UWCCR VENDING AGREEMENT




- Improved Finances
 - Increase Indirect Cost Contribution to General Fund Between \$100K to 135K
 - Student Nutrition Services Will be Fiscally
 Solvent and Contribute to General Fund
- Employee Opportunities
 - Staff Training, Leadership Training, and Restorative Practices Workshops.
 - Increased Working Hours for Current District Employees

SNS, DISTRICT BENEFITS FROM UWCCR VENDING AGREEMENT



- Investments in the SNS Program
 - Purchase/Replace Kitchen equipment
 - Purchase Refrigerated Truck and "Wrap" both Refrigerated Trucks supporting a Marketing Strategy for SNS and DJUSD
 - Future Purchase of Mobile Food Truck for lunch and other school and community events
 - Revenue to Invest in Marketing Strategy toward Parent Community and Students.

SNS, DISTRICT BENEFITS FROM UWCCR VENDING AGREEMENT



- Community Benefits
 - Create Jobs for the Davis Community.
 - Increase Local Procurement from 55% to 65%.
 - Contribute estimated revenue of \$200,000 to Local Economy in Yolo County and Sacramento Valley Region.
