I am pleased to inform you that the Davis Senior High School Agriculture program has been approved for funding through the California Career Pathways Trust Central Region Agricultural Education Career Pathway consortium for the Agricultural Mechanics and Agriscience pathways. The total amount of funding approved is \$168,202.00 of which 42% will be available for the 2015-16 fiscal year and 58% during the 2016-17 fiscal year.

The CRAECP Consortium looks forward to working with you, your Agriculture Department Chair Ellie Michel and the entire Agriculture staff, in meeting the major grant objectives of:

- Improving the quality of high school and community college Agricultural Mechanics, Agriscience and Ornamental Horticulture pathway programs.
- Increasing the successful transition of students into aligned postsecondary programs in the Agricultural Mechanics, Agriscience and Ornamental Horticulture pathways.
- Building upon existing partnerships with regional employers to successfully transition students to careers in the Agricultural Mechanics, Agriscience and Ornamental Horticulture pathways.

The Memorandum of Understanding which I have provided will serve as the Davis Senior High School / Davis Joint Unified School District agreement with the CRAECP Consortium in regards to this award.
