WHO: Summer school classes are for students who will be in grades 8-12 during the 2016-17 school year and who need credit recovery or need to remediate D or F grades in required courses.

WHERE: Harper Junior High, 4000 E. Covell Blvd., Davis, CA 95618

WHEN: Six-week courses: June 20 to July 28.
Classes meet 5 days a week.

Three-Week/Semester Courses:
Session 1: June 20 to July 8
Session 2: July 11 to July 28

No school Monday, July 4 for the Independence Day holiday

DAILY SCHEDULE: All classes will be held according to the following schedule:

Periods 1 & 2	8:00 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.
Break	10:15 a.m. - 10:35 a.m. <i>Closed campus for all students</i>
Periods 3 & 4	10:35 a.m. - 12:50 p.m.

WHAT IS THE ENROLLMENT PRIORITY?

District students who attend any DJUSD school and

- 1st priority: need English language arts intervention instruction to meet district grade level standards.
- 2nd priority: need make-up credit to promote or meet district graduation requirements.
- 3rd priority: want to raise a pre-existing D or F grade

IMPORTANT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

- Under state guidelines, summer school requires 12 contact hours for one credit, whereas 16 hours are required during the regular school year to receive the same credit. The significant reduction of contact time may affect depth, breadth, pace, and rigor of the curriculum presented. These factors may be an advantage or disadvantage to any individual student's needs. Therefore, parents/guardians and students should weigh the course selections carefully, especially if the course is needed as a prerequisite for future courses.
- Core academic classes are only funded up to 5% of the school year enrollment. The number of sections offered during the summer will be determined by the state's funding formula, availability of qualified staff, and the number of students requesting the course.
- All students, without exception, who miss more than 1½ days per three week session, due to absence or tardies, will be dropped from the class and will NOT be granted credit. Please be aware that tardies accumulate and are counted as a percentage of overall absences. Three tardies equal one period absence. Students admitted after the first day of summer school will have the number of days they may miss reduced accordingly.
- Any student dropped, or who chooses to drop after July 1 for the first semester or July 22 for the second semester will receive an F in the course.
- The staff expects a high standard of behavior for all students.
- Classes may not be audited.
- Current 7th and 8th graders who have a failing grade (F) in English, Social Studies, and/or Science will be contacted by the counselor during the last quarter of the school year to complete summer school enrollment.

REGISTRATION FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION EXTENDED SCHOOL (ESY) YEAR PROGRAM:

The Davis Joint Unified School District offers a special education extended school year program under the guidelines of the California Education Code. The student's Individual Education Program (IEP) team members make the determination that a student is eligible for extended year. In general, the extended school year program serves students who demonstrate significant and lifelong disabilities. The extended school year special education special day class program occurs during the District's summer school program and on the same campus. Please contact your child's special education teacher if you have any questions regarding your child's eligibility for the program or the registration procedure. Students with IEP's that have less severe disabilities may enroll in the District's summer school program under the same guidelines as other students in the District. Participation is up to the parent/guardian, and does not typically include special education support services. 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1. Summer school classes are for students who will be in grades 8-12 during the 2016-17 school year and who need credit recovery or need to remediate D or F grades in required courses.
2. Please complete all pages of this application carefully. Incomplete applications will be returned. If any part of your application is not complete, it will be returned to you. We need 2 daytime phone numbers for parents and at least one emergency contact phone number of someone other than a parent/guardian. **It is imperative that you provide more than 1 daytime phone number; this is for your student's protection in case of emergency.**
3. Attached is the registration form for enrolling in specific classes. Fill in your name and current grade level at the top of the Registration Form.
4. Indicate your first and second choice of classes in the left hand box
5. **All applications require a counselor's signature.** Applications will be returned to the school if the counselor has not signed the application prior to submission.
6. Staffing for summer school will be done on the basis of the number of applications returned by April 22nd. After that time, classes will be filled on a space-available basis. Under-enrolled classes may be canceled. A confirmation letter will be sent to you in mid-May. If your student is on the waiting list, they will be notified as vacancies occur and/or should report to the summer school office on June 21st. After that time, registration will be accepted on a space-available basis.
7. Be sure the pages of your application are stapled together. Return your completed application as soon as possible to the counseling office at your school or to the Summer School Office, Davis Joint Unified School District, 526 B Street, Davis, CA 95616.
