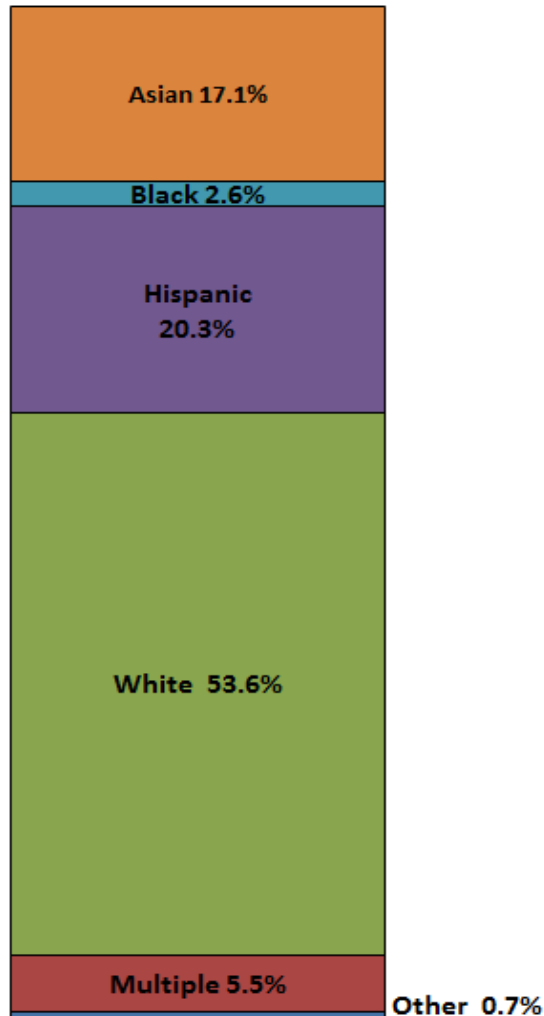

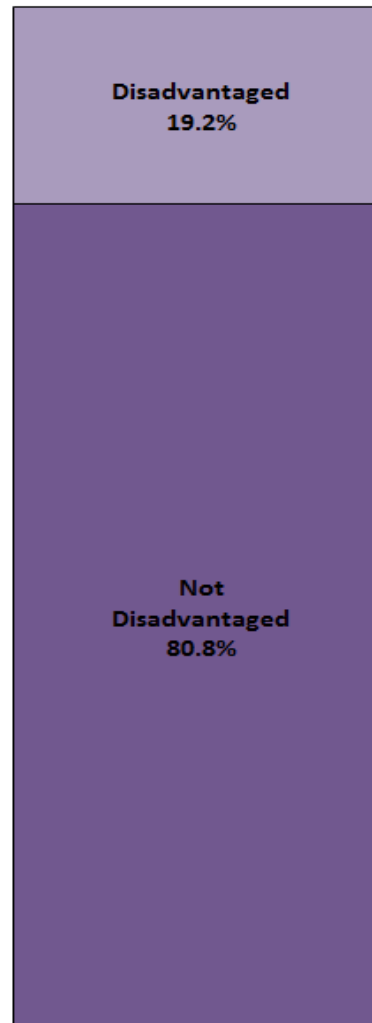
# 2015-16 DJUSD ENROLLMENT DEMOGRAPHICS



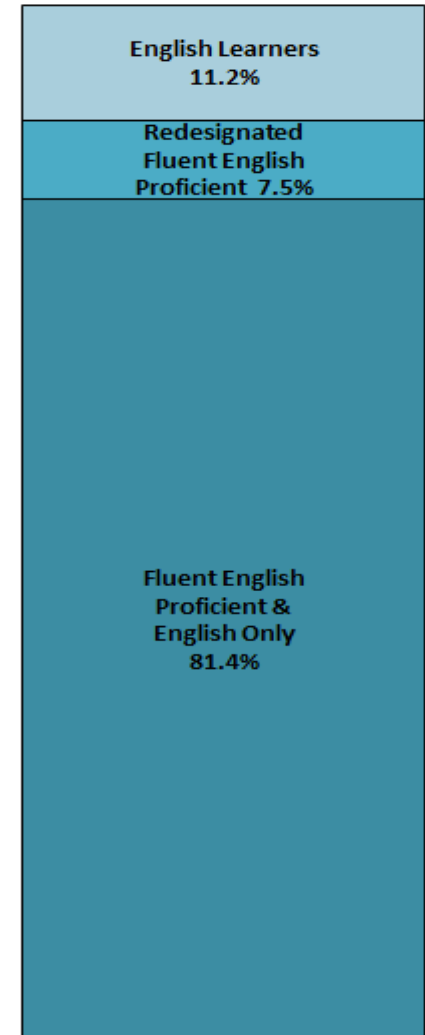
## Ethnicity



## Socio-Economic Status



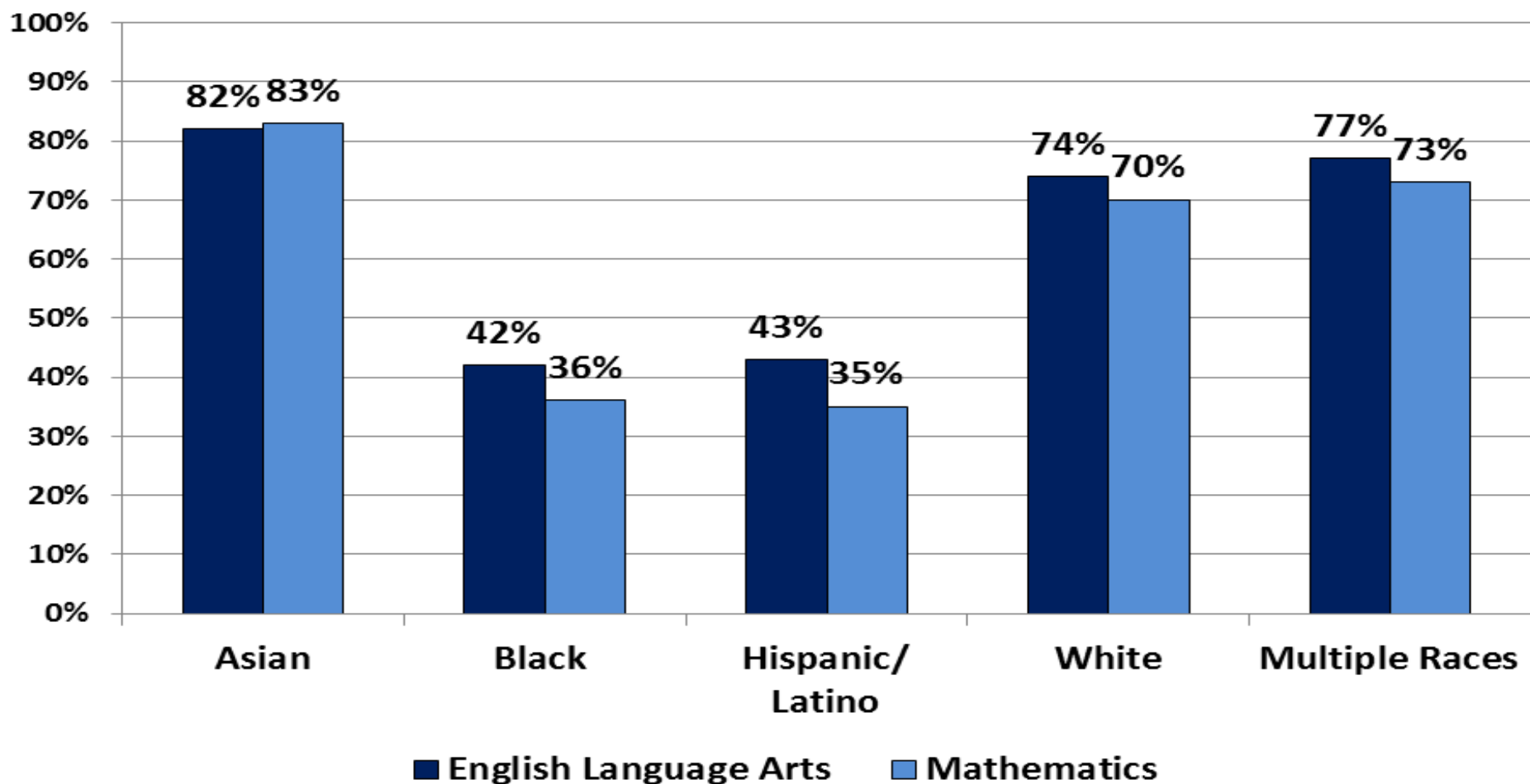
## English Language Proficiency



# 2015 STATE TESTING RESULTS BY ETHNICITY



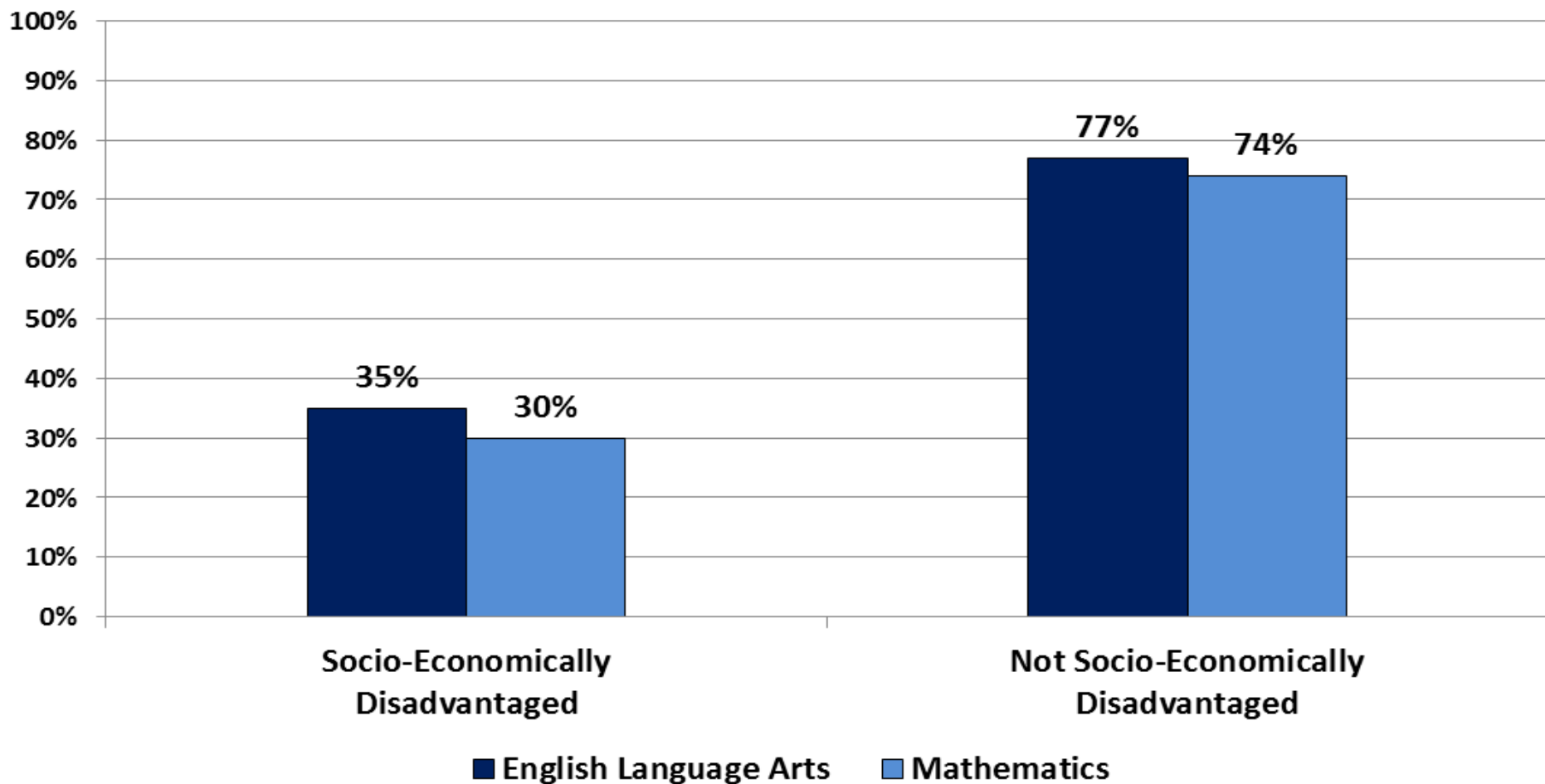

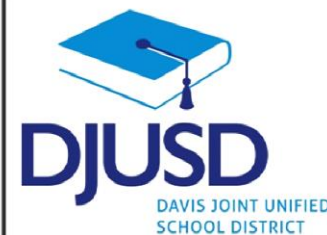
# 2015 STATE TESTING RESULTS BY SOCIO-ECONOMIC STATUS



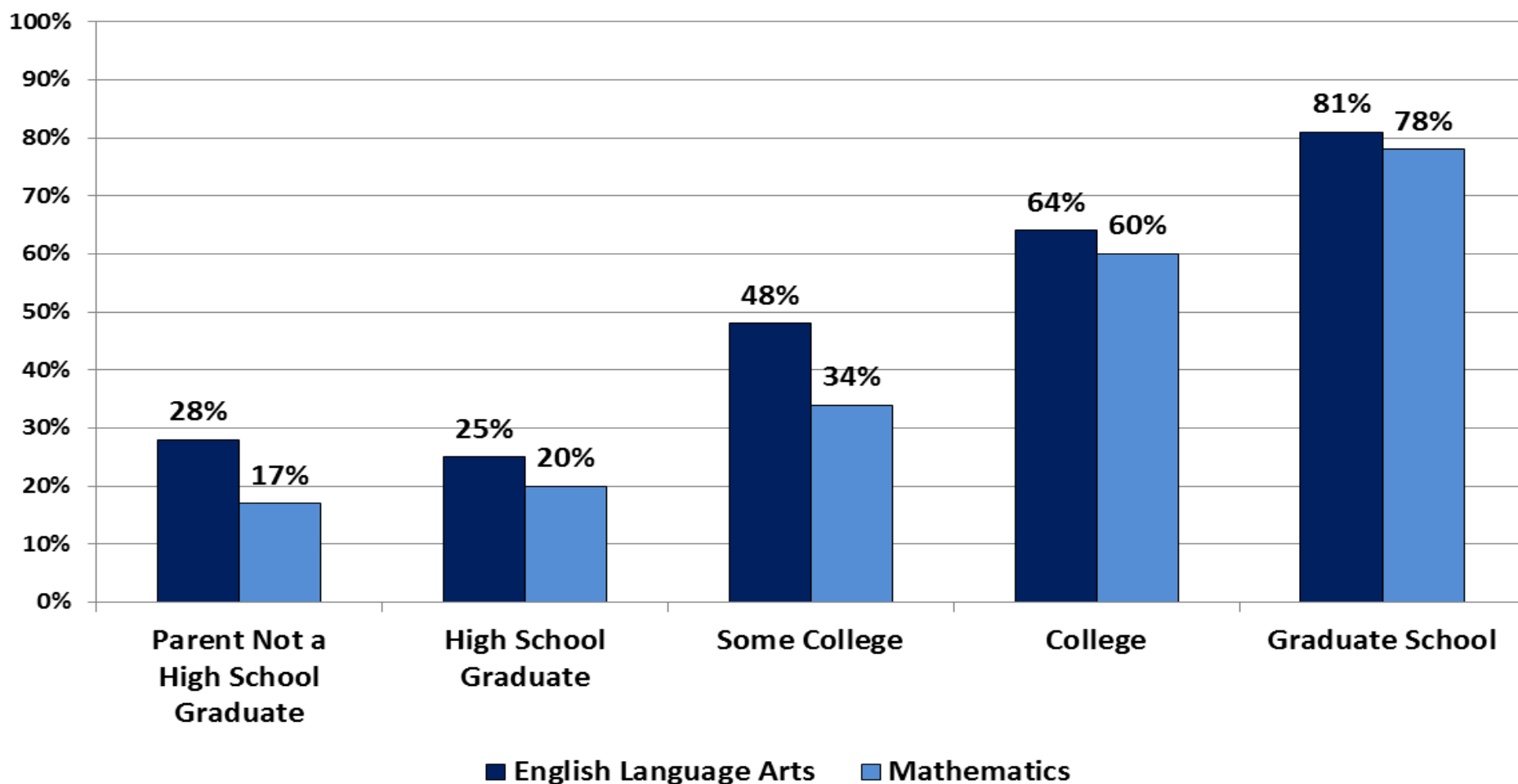

# 2015 STATE TESTING RESULTS BY PARENT EDUCATION LEVEL



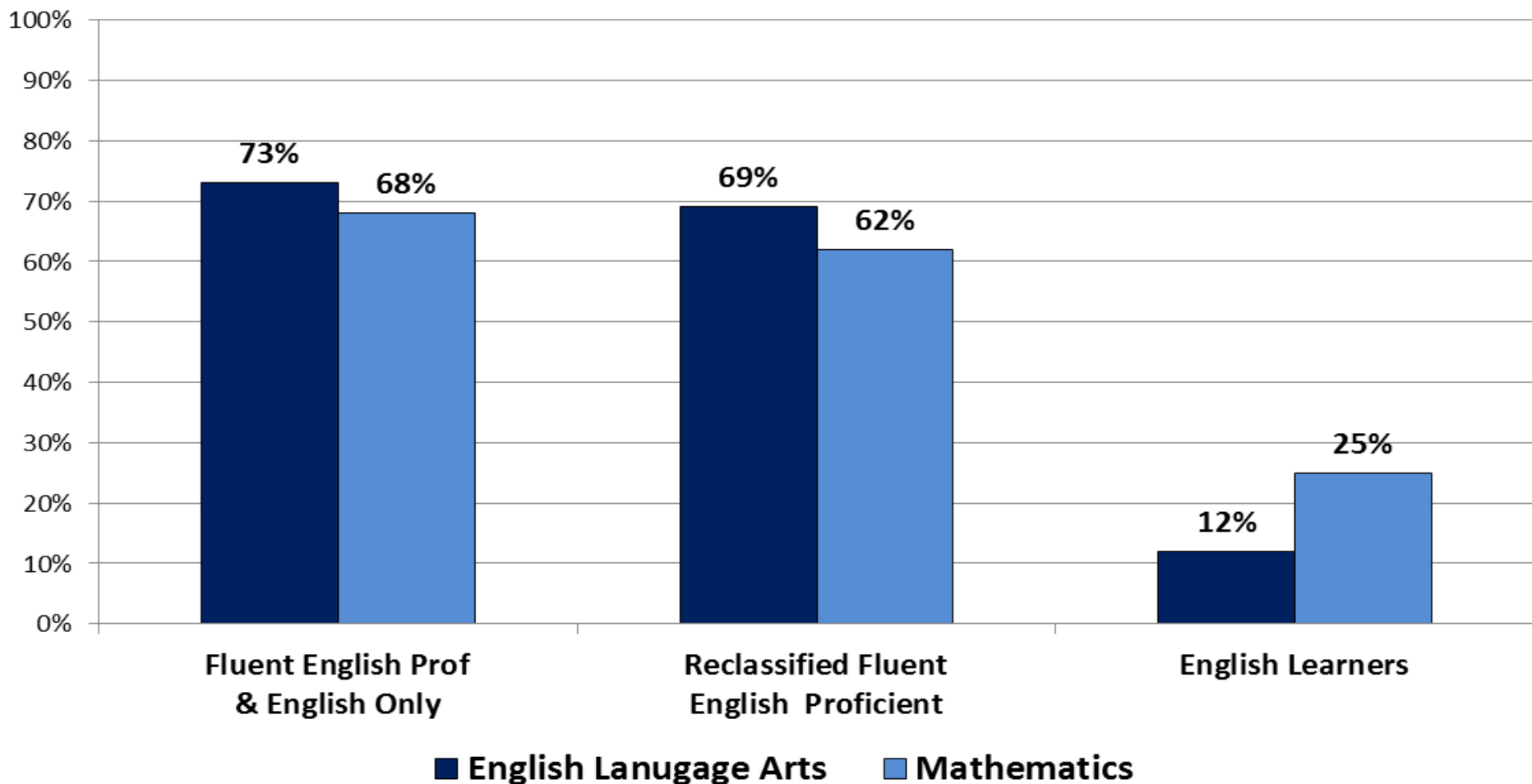
