

Administration of IAB

- Go to www.caaspp.org and click on Test Administrator Interface
- Log into your CAASPP account using the login and password you used for the administration of the SBAC.
- Choose the **Smarter Interim Assessment Block** under Category
- Choose either ELA Read Info (IAB) or ELA Read Lit (IAB)
- Click Start session

Scoring the IAB

- Go to www.caaspp.org and click on Interim Assessment Hand Scoring System
- Log into your CAASPP account using the login and password you used for the administration of the SBAC
- Choose the test you would like to score
- Click on the student you would like to score
- Use the provided rubrics and follow the directions to score the constructed response answers.
