

CONTRACT NAME: AGREEMENT BETWEEN CENTER FOR LAND BASED LEARNING AND DAVIS JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CONTRACT: This is an agreement between Center for Land Based Learning and DJUSD. It is a field trip program that will give Davis Senior High School students an opportunity to work with mentors from UC Davis or the Yolo County Resource Conservation District in small groups to learn about native habitats while applying science concepts to real world situations.

Students will learn about opportunities regarding career and college possibilities. The program helps build leadership skills and allows students to develop portfolios for college and careers.

The cost of the program is \$650 and is funded by the site discretionary budget and donations.




INFORMATION, TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE SLEWS PROGRAM

- **PARTICIPATION FEES:** The SLEWS Program requires a cost share of \$650 for 3 field days, \$800 for 4 field days and \$1,000 for 5 field days. Participation fees can be paid by parents of the student, the school or school district, local sponsors or through fundraising activities. The SLEWS coordinator can help brainstorm ideas and suggest fundraising ideas supported by the Center for Land-Based Learning. Financial assistance for participation fees is available, however, conditions apply. (Conditions: Schools must pay for all or part of the cost of substitutes and/or transportation. Schools that cannot support the program with any of these costs will be asked to consider fundraising or seek local sponsors.)
- **TRANSPORTATION:** Each SLEWS teacher/school needs to schedule its own transportation. If the school cannot cover transportation costs, upon mutual agreement and as specified on this form, the School/District may invoice the Center Land-Based Learning actual costs up to \$600 per field day towards the cost of bus transportation. Costs exceeding \$600 per field day must be paid by the School/District.
- **SUBSTITUTES:** We will reimburse the district (or school) for the cost of ONE substitute teacher per school, per day. We will reimburse only for the exact cost of the substitute teacher, UP TO \$150.00/day, and backup paperwork must be attached to the invoice.
- **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:** Financial Assistance for Participation Fees is available to new and returning SLEWS schools. Financial assistance is limited and dependent on available funding. Financial assistance amounts will be determined once all applications are processed and reviewed by Land-Based Learning staff and the Board of Directors. To apply, contact your program coordinator for an application.
- **INVOICING LAND-BASED LEARNING:** Invoices must be received no later than June 16th 2017. We cannot guarantee payment on invoices for 2016-2017 school year received after June 30, 2017. *Invoices will be paid quarterly.*
