

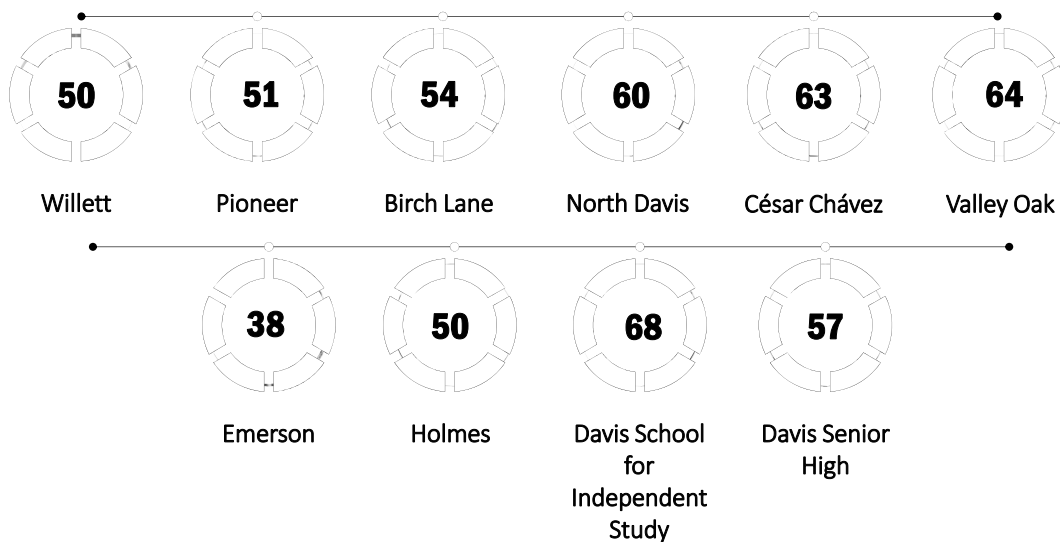

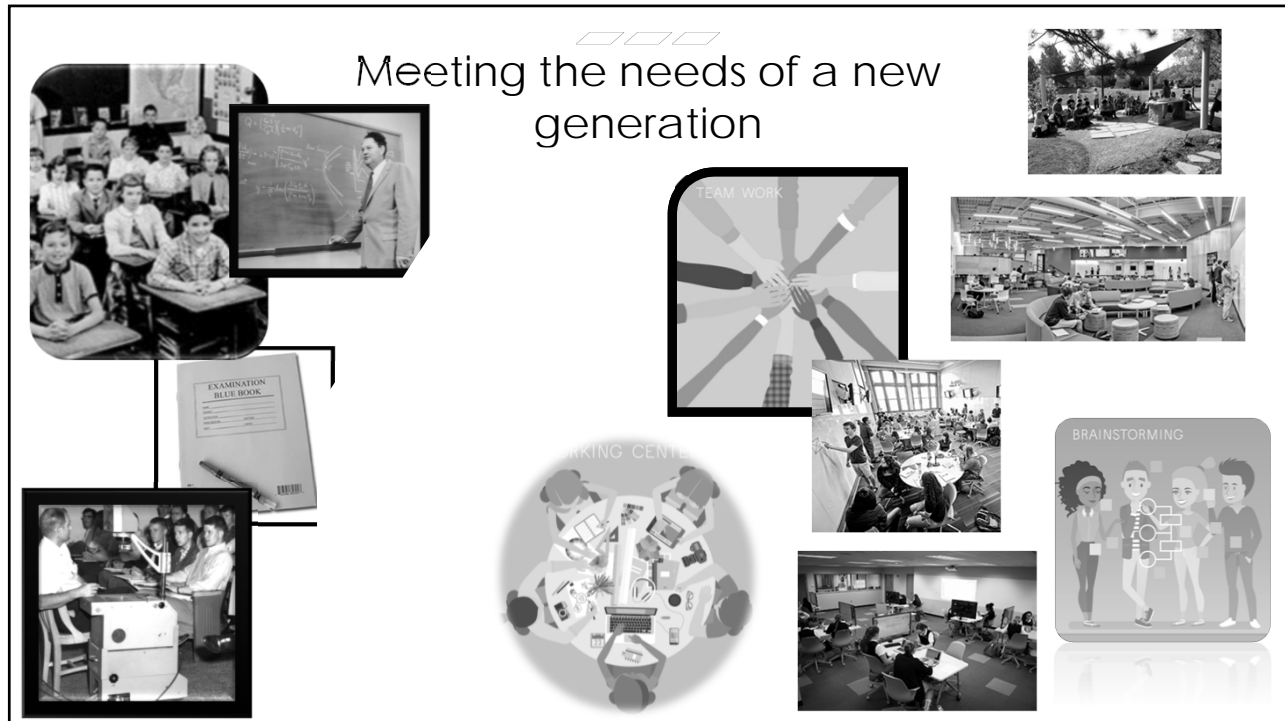

Most are 30-50 years old.

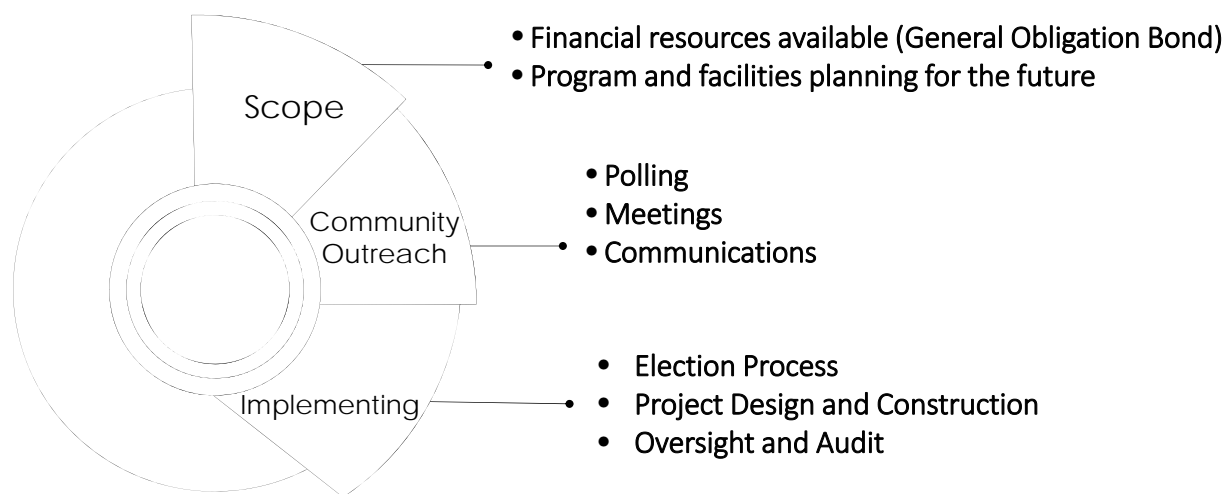
### Historic School Buildings (Age in years)

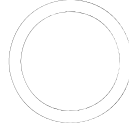

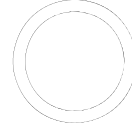

bond tax rate



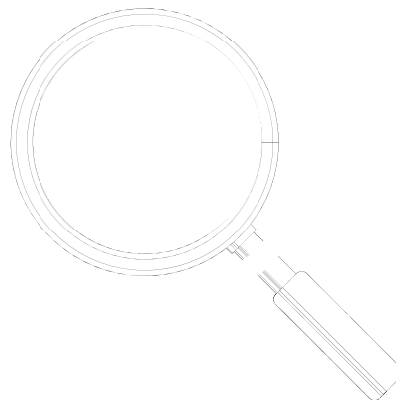
### Bond Tax Rate
