

CONTRACT NAME: AGREEMENT BETWEEN KAISER FOUNDATION HEALTH PLAN, INC., AND DAVIS JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CONTRACT: This performance agreement between Kaiser Permanente and DJUSD is regarding Kaiser's program *Nightmare on Puberty St.* The hour-long program is intended to use humor and performance to address the anxieties surrounding growing up. The show addresses the same issues discussed in health classes: resisting and overcoming negative peer pressure, coping with depression and recognizing the normal changes experienced during puberty. Parents receive advance notification about the performance and have the opportunity to opt out for their student.

Harper Junior High's performance is on Friday, December 8, 2017.

Emerson and DaVinci Junior High's performance is on Monday, December 4, 2017.

Holmes Junior High's performance is to be scheduled.

FISCAL IMPACT: The performances are free, funded by Kaiser Permanente.

Site's Responsibilities:


- 1) Site will assign a Site Contact who will have the following responsibilities:
