





- 242 students:

- 35 students: Focus on English/Social Studies credit
- recovery


DSHS Session 2:

- 260 students:
 - 91% earned C or better credit toward A-G eligibility
 - 98% of students earned credit toward graduation

- 26 students: Focus on finishing credits for graduation and credit recovery
